KOLONNE NULL - FROM THE LABORATORY IN BERLIN

Kolinne Null pride themselves on first and foremost on being explorers and pioneers. With their sights firmly set on allowing larger audiences to discover their offering, their aim is to create finest non-alcoholic wines from diverse regions throughout the world.

The Kolonne Null passion to be the best in this space has led them to travel extensively, procuring over 1000 wines to place through their de-alcoholisation process. They take time to closely measure and observe changes to wine, seeking out the finest flavours and aromas for their collection. Dedicated to their partnerships with the vineyards and wineries as well as conducting experiments and tests on unique equipment in Germany, Spain, and California, they have conducted assessments utilising the best methods of thermal separation for vacuum rectification, blending, membrane filtration, and sweetening options.

DE-ALCOHOLIZATION & REFINEMENT

Non-alcoholic wines can be produced via an array of differing methods. Fundamentally the process relies on de-alcoholisation by vacuum distillation to gently remove the alcohol from selected wines down to a maximum residual alcohol content of 0.3%. The thermal vacuum method in particular has an advantage in that the alcohol escapes at a low temperature of 30°C. This method allows assessors to keep the structure of the original wine intact while delicately separating the alcohol.

This method is immediately followed by aroma recovery to capture the distinct aromas from the wine. This preserves the diverse character and overall style of each individual wine, to uphold the highest of standards. This process does not employ the use of artificial flavours or colours.

Sweetness that is diminished through the de-alcoholisation process is reintroduced with natural sugars to maintain an overall delicate flavour. Depending on the variety of wine, CO2 may be added to give it a sparkling character.

Kolonne Null invest a great deal of time and resources into the detail and approach their products with absolute dedication - from the grape on the vine to bottling and sharing with you, the customer.

This results in a completely new and fresh non-alcoholic alternative to alcohol.


BIRTHPLACES OF AUSTRALIAN WINE

The areas surrounding Sydney have the longest grape growing histories in Australia. The original grape vines came with the First Fleet and were planted at Sydney Cove in 1788. New South Wales is Australia's most populated state, however it represents only around 30% of Australia's total production on an annual basis. Following on from the initial vines arriving in 1788, Captain John Macarthur planted vines near Camden and Gregory Blaxland planted vineyards around the Parramatta River in the early 1800s. James Busby's collection of 362 vines, originally planted at the Botanical Gardens, was the most significant development in the early history, and cuttings from these specific vines made their way to other parts of NSW, Victoria, and South Australia.

The State, boasts an incredibly diverse range of climates, including coastal (Shoalhaven Coast region lying south of Sydney) to Alpine (across the top of the Great Dividing Range), where hardy growers persist at over 500m above sea level.

Moving west over the Great Dividing Range and along the inland flowing Murrumbidgee and Murray Rivers are the warm-climate regions of Riverina and Perricoota, and the northern portion of the Swan Hill and Murray Darling. One of Australia's most renowned and historic wine regions - the Hunter Valley - is located just north of Sydney, Australia's bustling multicultural business and centre.

ANCIENT SOILS, ANCIENT CULTURE

Munda is the Indigenous Wirangu and Kokatha word for land, expressing the rich history of the select place from which it's cultivated.

For over 80,000 years these sacred regions have made up Kaurna Country, Ngadjuri or Peramangk Country. Munda Wines proudly celebrates these Aboriginal Countries, as well as the people who have lived here, thrived here, and have lovingly tended the munda.

Munda Wines in collaboration with artisan winemakers from the specific countries mentioned have partnered in deep respect for munda. Indeed, winemakers and viticulturalists who grow *vitis vinifera* (grape vine) in these regions have done so for many decades, across generations. They understand the unique landscapes and climates in which they cultivate their vines, ensuring respect to munda in all their undertakings.

The distinct wine style of Munda Wines is to stay true to the tastes and body of the munda. Utilising minimal interventions, as well as using oak regimes to showcase munda, and preferring to bottle relatively early.

Most importantly and integral to the work that Munda Wines produce, is work with their winery partners and the Tjindu Foundation. Creating tangible pathways and an array of opportunities for Indigenous people to foray into the wine industry.

BROKENWOOD - HUNTER VALLEY, NSW

Established in 1970, Brokenwood Wines has evolved from a weekend venture from self-professed “hobby” winemakers into one of Australia’s most respectable wine labels.

The first vintage was picked in 1973 and whilst none of the original partners had experience in the field of viticulture, the wine received notable accolades, and attracted a loyal following from the very first vintage.

In 1975, a new winery was built to accommodate the fast-accelerating production. Early customers were able to taste the limited vintage made by the hobby winemakers, from a humble table stand under the shade of a first-floor balcony, no less.

In 1982, the company extended its range to include white wines, notably the jewel of the Hunter Valley, Sémillon. With this broadened exposure to winemaking, the partners decided to consolidate further growth with the introduction of someone who could act as both Chief Winemaker and Managing Director.

Iain Riggs joined Brokenwood in 1982, introducing winery equipment, specifically for the production of premium white wine. Brokenwood has now been producing high quality white wine since 1983.

Since then, Graveyard Vineyard Shiraz has gained considerable international recognition. The Langton's Classification of Australian Wine has it listed as the highest rated Hunter Valley red wine, outlining it as ‘Exceptional.’



Situated in the North-East of France, Champagne has become the benchmark for sparkling wine.

In the Champagne region, consistently unique bubbles are result of the exceptional conditions of the region, as well as the winemaking method that is known as the “Champagne method.” This excellent combination of conditions is what makes it the world’s most prominent sparkling wine.

Territories here are divided into sub-regions, and each of them has slightly varying and distinct Champagne characteristics: Reims, Marne Valley, Côte des Blancs, Côte des Bar, Côte de Sézanne.



With 102,000 hectares, the German wine country is a medium-sized wine nation as far as the vineyard area is concerned. However it does receive attention from discerning wine drinkers around the world – a noted location to watch. 75% of wines coming from German wine regions are slightly filigree with highly intense aromatics and flavoursome whites. The cool climate proves to be a great advantage for white wines as it rests rapid sugar maturation and promotes robust physiological maturity.

There are 13 German wine regions that provide a wide range of different soils: slate, lime, marl, primary rock, and volcanic rock. This multifaceted nature of terroirs in German wine regions creates quality, high-mineral wines.

BURGUNDY WINE MAP

Burgundy wine region is considered the benchmark of excellence.

Vineyards extend from Dijon to Mâcon. The clear demarcation of land was undertaken centuries ago by local monks, whereby land was divided into small plots called ‘Climats,’ which are currently protected by UNESCO.

Around 60% of the production here is centred around white wine - Chardonnay and Aligoté. 30% is dedicated to red wine - Pinot Noir and Gamay, and the last 10% represent the sparkling wine Crémant de Bourgogne.

The most prestigious appellations are Chambertin, Clos-de-Vougeot, Clos-des-Lambrays, Musigny, Romanée-Conti, Fixin, Nuits-Saint-Georges.


The Piedmont wine region is located in the northwest of Italy.

There are five broad sub-regions in Piedmont: Canavese, Colline Novaresi, Coste della Sesia, Langhe, and Monferrato. These regions produce the renowned appellations Barolo, Barbaresco, and Barbera d'Alba.

The Piedmont wine region's most planted grapes are Barbera, Nebbiolo, and Dolcetto specifically for red wine production. Moscato is the most significant grape for sparkling and frizzante style wines.



Tuscany is renowned throughout Europe as being a central wine producing hub. It is made up of 23,000 square kilometres within central Italy and is famous for its Sangiovese-based dry red wines - the leaders in terms of Tuscany's production. These include Chianti, Brunello di Montalcino and Vino Nobile di Montepulciano.

Spain has more land under grapes than any other country. Indeed over 30% more than in France or Italy. Portugal is the fourth highest ranker in terms of area under grapes in Europe.

Iberian wine grape varieties, particularly Tempranillo from Spain, and Touriga Nacional from Portugal have been planted extensively around the globe, including in Australia.







There are many exquisite wines in Bordeaux, however the crème de la crème is the classic blend Cabernet Sauvignon-Merlot.

The red wines made with these grapes carry distinguished characteristics of the terroir, resulting in their sophisticated price points.
